Committee Reports:

Planning Board- Commissioner Hozik reported that the recent settlement with Wawa was discussed and that resolutions from previous meetings were approved.

<u>Town Council-</u> Councilman Furgione reported that a major project to remediate a plume of groundwater contamination under Lincoln Street is being planned for. The remediation will be paid for by South Jersey Industries and is likely to begin in 2016.

1. 7th Annual Hammonton Lake Park Cleanup: Reitmeyer reported that the cleanup has had to be postponed due to snow events, but is expected to take place this coming Saturday, March 14th. All previous planning remains the same and all Commissioners were asked to keep soliciting for volunteers.

New Business:

- 1. <u>2015 ANJEC Open Space Grant:</u> Various potential proposals were discussed. Reitmeyer requested that Councilman Furgione bring up for Council approval a motion to authorize the Commission proposal once finalized. Reitmeyer will finalize the proposal in coordination with Councilman Furgione, Administrator Jerry Barberio, Amy Menzel and Dan Bachalis.
- 2. <u>2015 Arbor Day Celebration:</u> Reitmeyer reported that he is waiting to hear back from arborist Mickey Riggins on availability for school presentation. Also discussed was purchasing tree tubelings as per previous years through the State Forest Nursery. Motion to purchase 392 tubelings for a cost of \$100.00 by Commissioner Caruso-Cafiso, seconded by Commissioner Menzel. All in favor, Motion approved.

Other New Business:

1. Commissioner Jage reported that the Pinelands Preservation Alliance is requesting a letter of support from the Commission regarding the use of all-terrain vehicles on State lands. A Motion to provide this Letter of Support was made by Commissioner Caruso-Cafiso and seconded by Commissioner Hozik. All in Favor. Motion Approved. Commissioner Jage recused himself.
