**Bulky Waste:** Collected by Public Works the 1st full week of each month. **NO curbside removal of rug/padding.**

**Brush/Yard Waste:** Collected by Public Works during the 2nd full week of each month

**Holiday Food Drive - December 8 - 12:** Place your food donation curbside on your recycling day.

**Earth Day Festival:** 10 am - 4 pm, 6700 Delilah Rd, EHT 08234 (rain or shine) Join us for entertainment, workshops, tours, hayrides & more!

## Disposal Information

**Electronics:** ACUA does not accept electronics. Hammonton collects electronics from **residents only** along with bulky waste items. [www.townofhammonton.org/electronic-waste-disposal/](http://www.townofhammonton.org/electronic-waste-disposal/)

**Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://www.acua.com/paint)

**Shredded Paper:** Shredded paper cannot be recycled curbside, but can be recycled at ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://www.acua.com/rcdropoffs)

**Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off day. [acua.com/hhw](http://www.acua.com/hhw)
